This program takes families from the Red Cross Homeless Shelter and abused and battered woman with children from A Woman's Place and move's them into temporary apartments that are free of charge to the tenant. In order for a family to qualify for this program the parents must be willing to make a change to better further themselves and their family. The philosophy is that if you affect the parents it will positively affect the lives of their children. While in this temporary housing the children attend daycare/school and the parent(s) must attend some sort of career training program and financial budget counseling. A family may be eligible for this housing for 4-10 months in which case they then move up and into a transitional housing apartment program. We are hosting our third annual golf event to raise money to provide the necessities such as sheets, pillows, rugs, towels, shower curtains, toothpaste, cleaning products, pots and pans, clothes, first aid supplies, etc that are needed when a family first moves in. We are hoping to again help make this difficult transitional period in their life just a little bit more positive. We were given the opportunity in the last two years to use our raised funds (which you helped raise over \$15,000) to provide the 6 families with Food for their pantry, Halloween gift baskets, Thanksgiving gift baskets and Christmas gift cards to practice their newly acquired budget knowledge. The volunteer coordinator, Kathy, from last year has moved up in the company and our new volunteer, Alex have poured their heart and soul into this program. Alex coordinates all moves in and out, the cleaning and preparing of the apartments, the day to day operations of the tenants and the facility. She even makes time to run a small food pantry out of her office for the residents in need. We are Passionate about this project and will be continuing our ongoing relationship with the Morrisville Shelter Program.

Attached you will find a sponsorship form. All profits will be used as they were last year; to provide holiday meals, holiday gifts, food pantry items and for items for the new tenants as they move into the apartments throughout the year.
